Each of us has children, grandchildren, and or family and acquaintances with children in high school and above; and we ask that you and or your spouse pass this vital resource on to them.

A Catholic Respect Life Curriculum For High School College and Adult Study is a free teaching program available on-line which can be downloaded in minutes from our website. It has as it's primary source the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, excerpts of Encyclicals, and other Church documents, as well as several documents from Priests For Life. It is a complete program that also addresses the scientific facts of when life begins.

Our objective is to promote it to Catholic school systems throughout the state and nation, but this is a very long-term process and since it is ready to be used today we want to share it with everyone now.

The curriculum has 15 lessons, which average about three pages each. There are 3 tests that cover the three 5-block lessons. The appendix contains resources such as on-line documents to support specific topics, and it also contains video resources that will greatly enhance the reading portion of the lessons.

If you want your children or grandchildren to learn more fully what the Church teaches about life from “womb to tomb” then we urge you to download and begin using this program today. We also want to encourage Knights and their wives to study this program themselves and wherever possible study it together with children as a family.

This program in its totality will leave students with a well-rounded understanding of the Church's teachings on the sanctity of life in its continuum from conception to natural death. It will also challenge them to see the beauty and humanity of the unborn; and hopefully to become personally involved in what Pope John Paul II described as the great struggle between the culture of life and the culture of death.
